### Grayson Quarterly Report Overview

We are able to execute our PAL afterschool program with an average of thirty children every day thanks to the assistance of our staff members Elsa, Emilio, Helena, and Luchie. Over the coming months, we want to keep increasing our attendance even greater. As part of PAL's continuous efforts to assist kids in improving their education, we assist students with their coursework throughout the year by providing several activities and opportunities. We have hired a third staff member to ensure the program operates at its best. This will help the kids learn a more structured curriculum, link them with Stanislaus County Sheriff's deputies, and further improve staff assistance. For the month of April we were able to host a small Easter Egg Hunt, students came out and participated. Although the staff prepare lesson plans every day, we naturally take into account what the kids love doing and make a few accommodations. Given the lovely grassy places we have, outdoor activities appear to be increasingly popular. We also had an opportunity to take ten students to The Tech Interactive Museum in San Jose, please see the picture below. May was an exciting month for our students as we celebrated Dia Del Nino alongside V.I.P on May 2nd. Some of our PAL kids graduated high school and were promoted within grades, congratulations to them! In the month of June we started our Summer Program which changed our hours of operation to 12PM - 5PM. With the generous support from Patterson Unified Nutrition Services, we were able to provide all the students summer lunches until the end of July. June has been more warm than usual so we decided to take two trips out to Patterson's aquatics center, ten students attended each trip. We will also be visiting AMR in Modesto so that our students learn about a potential career opportunity. We look forward to hosting many more students at our program, thank you to everyone who contributes into making it possible for the kids.

Greeting Board Members, I hope everyone has been well. This report will highlight Grayson's Library services for April 2025 to June 2025. Library staff continues with implementing activities and programs for the youth. Recently, we again had the opportunity to collaborate with Modesto Children's Museum implemented a Robotics program on June 5, 2025. We had 17 in attendance. The 2025 Summer Reading Challenge is in full swing. So far, we have over a dozen youth signed up. We encourage everyone to sign up. There are prizes for all ages. Including a iPad, Nintendo switch and LEGO 3 in 1 Castle Toy for the youth (0- 17 age), one free book and teens and adults can win an iPad, Xbox Series x, Ameta Drone and Nintendo Switch. We also hosted Uncle Jer's Traveling Bee Show on June 26, 2025. For the month of May, Library staff implemented an 'end of the year dance party' and this was a big hit! We will implement again, especially since the youth have requested, we do it again. For the upcoming months, we will continue to encourage youth and everyone else to participate in the Summer Reading Challenge. Additional art programs will be implemented and another Modesto Children's Museum program and a critter show. Library staff will be supporting Invest in Me's 2nd Annual Senior Health Fair on Friday, August 22, 2025. We supported this event last year and we enjoyed sharing resources with community members.
